What is the School doing to help?

- We provide morning supervision from 8.30 a.m. to 8.50 a.m. to allow children arrive in school earlier than school start time.
- Traffic Wardens are in place at either end of Crab Lane before and after school to help children cross the road.
- The Board of Management has raised concerns with the Dept. of Education in relation to parking facilities at our school.
- The school gate is monitored at drop-off and collection times.
- The Board of Management is consulting with the City Council about drop-off and pick-up times on Crab Lane.

What can you do to help?

- Walk, cycle, scoot to school with your child(ren).
- Consider “Park and Stride”- park your car on Boreenmanna Rd. or Blackrock Rd. and walk you child(ren) to the school gate.
- Avail of the 20 minutes of morning supervision provided by the school.
- Drop your child(ren) off on either the Boreenmanna Rd. or Blackrock Rd. end of Crab Lane where the traffic wardens are.
- Please also recognise that the morning school run can be equally stressful for parents and staff. You are trying to get your child(ren) to school on time and we are trying to meet the health and safety needs of our school community.

Do

- Do walk, cycle, scoot with your child to school.
- Do avail of supervision before school.
- Do park at either end of Crab Lane where the Traffic Wardens are situated.
- Do ensure school bags are easily accessible for drop-off.
- Do respect our neighbours.
- Do respect the rules of the road.

Don't

- Avoid driving through Crab Lane when dropping children to school.
- Do not stop outside the school gate and drop children to school.
- Do not park on the curb or block pedestrian crossings.
- Do not park on double yellow lines.
- Do not double park outside houses on Crab Lane.
